The size of the artwork could be 8.5 x 11 Inches, A4, 11 x 14 Inches or paper of any Standard Sketch Book.

Medium: Drawing, Painting, Collage and Mix Media.

Children can use Pencil, Coloured Pencil, Ink, Pastels Colours, Poster Colours, Water Colours & Acrylic Colours to create artworks only on good quality paper. (Do not Paste 3D material on artwork)


